### **Program Description**

Seventy-five full tuition scholarships will be awarded to Commonwealth citizens under the Commonwealth-Grenada St George's University Scholarship Program, which has been launched to commemorate the university's 30th anniversary in January 2007.

The scholarships cover both graduate and undergraduate degree programs and will be offered to 25 students pursuing the Master of Public Health (MPH) program; 10 for the Arts and Sciences bachelor degree program; 10 for the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) degree program; and 5 for the Doctor of Medicine (MD) degree program.

This scholarship program seeks to make tertiary education possible for top scholars in Commonwealth countries who might otherwise be unable to attend university. Preference will be given to students from developing countries and small states. Recipients will be required to return to their home countries and put their acquired education and skills to good use.

The award determinations will be made by the University's Commonwealth-Grenada Scholarship Committee based primarily on academic excellence, financial need and the student's commitment to the chosen discipline. We seek to nurture and encourage students of superior academic caliber to strike out and impact the development of industry and healthcare in their home country.

### **Application and Award Procedures**

Students must have an offer of acceptance from St. George's University into the program of their chosen discipline. The fully completed and signed scholarship application, with essay, should be sent to:

3) Applicants must be able to fund their living and travel expenses through their own personal resources or alternative funding sources.
