## (OPTIONAL) FINANCIAL AID

For US Citizens and Permanent Residents only: If you are seeking financial aid you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Upon acceptance to SGU, every student is assigned a dedicated **Financial Aid Counselor** who is available to help you complete the application process and can answer any questions you may have regarding the financing of your education at SGU.

## (OPTIONAL) APPLY FOR ACCOMMODATIONS SERVICES

Students seeking accommodations for disabilities are required to contact Student Accessibility and Accommodation Services (SAAS) located in the Dean of Students Office (DOS). We highly recommend applying for accommodations as early as possible. Completing and submitting the form, along with the associated comprehensive documentation, at least one month before classes begin, will allow for a more efficient and timely consideration of your request. If we do not receive the required documentation in a timely fashion, an eligibility determination may not be made, and accommodations may not be granted before the commencement of classes and examinations.
