

Grenada Pre-Travel Checklist

We can't wait to welcome you back to campus! But first, make sure you have everything on this mandatory checklist. When you have checked all boxes, you are ready to return!

TO DO BEFORE TRAVEL

- Get fully COVID-19 vaccinated
- Confirm passport valid for six months from date of arrival
- Secure airline ticket
- Complete SGU Flight Plan form
- Book quarantine accommodation
- Pre-pay for Grenada PCR test
- Complete Pure Safe Travel Authorization
- Complete SGU electronic customs form
- Get negative PCR result within 72 hours of arrival

CARRY ON DAY OF TRAVEL

- SGU Enrollment Letter
- Visa Upon Arrival Letter
- Airline ticket
- Pure Safe Travel Authorization Certificate
- Pre-paid Grenada PCR test receipt
- Quarantine accommodation booking confirmation
- Proof of vaccination card
- Copy of negative PCR test results
- Passport valid for six months from date of arrival

GET FULLY COVID-19 VACCINATED

- As part of our plan for a safe return to campus life, COVID-19 vaccinations will be required for all students, faculty, staff, administrators, vendors, and visitors on campus.
- All students must be vaccinated in the country in which they are residing.
- Travelers to Grenada are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a two-dose series, such as the Astra Zeneca, Pfizer, Moderna, Sinopharm or Sinovac vaccines and 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson and Johnson's Janssen vaccine
- Keep your COVID-19 vaccination card in a safe place. Take a photo with your phone as back-up.
- When you travel, pack it in your carry-on luggage and be ready to show your vaccine card to immigration authorities in Grenada.

VALID PASSPORT

- You will need a valid passport. Grenada requires passports to be valid for six months beyond the date of entry.

SGU FLIGHT PLAN FORM

- We have created a secure form so you can update us on your travel plans back to campus.
- When you have booked your flight to Grenada, visit the [Flight Plan Back to Campus portal](#) and log in with your SGU credentials to submit your flight details.

PROOF OF QUARANTINE ACCOMMODATION BOOKING

ON CAMPUS

- If you are residing on campus, you will be required to quarantine in your dorm room until you have been cleared.
- When applying for the Grenada Pure Safe Travel Authorization Certificate you will need to provide the accommodation confirmation number sent to you by the SGU housing office.
- If you are quarantining on campus, select "Apartment" as the approved quarantine accommodation type and then "SGU Campus True Blue" as the property name.
- Once you have cleared Immigration and Customs you will be transported to your dorm room to begin your mandatory 48-hour quarantine on campus.

OFF CAMPUS

- If you are residing off campus, you will be required to quarantine at a state approved quarantine facility
- If you are traveling with your family, and wish to quarantine with them off campus, you will need to book a [Pure Safe Travel Property](#)
- If you are traveling with unvaccinated members, your travel party will be treated as unvaccinated, and you will have to book a state approved quarantine facility for a minimum of 7 days and remain in isolated quarantine up to day 7 regardless of whether negative test results have been received.

PRE-PAID GRENADA PCR PAYMENT RECEIPT

- Visit Grenada's [Ministry of Health website](#) and select Pay Online COVID-19 Test to pre-pay
- The PCR test costs EC\$405, which is equivalent to US\$150 and will cover your PCR test administered at the airport.

PURE SAFE TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION

- The Ministry of Health in Grenada is also requiring a Pure Safe Travel Certificate. This certificate grants authorization to travel to Grenada.
- Visit Grenada's [Ministry of Health website](#) and select Pure Safe Travel Authorization to apply.
- You do not have to purchase the monitoring bracelet.

SGU ELECTRONIC CUSTOMS FORM

- If you are travelling to Grenada for the first time, SGU will cover the customs fees for up to three electronic devices that you register, for example, your cell phone, laptop and/or tablet.
- Bring a receipt for any additional devices if you have one. If you do not have a receipt, the custom fee will be calculated based on the estimated value of the device.
- Complete [this form](#) to register your devices.

COPY OF NEGATIVE PCR RESULT WITHIN 72 HOURS OF ARRIVAL

- You will also need to have a negative PCR test within 72 hours of your arrival to Grenada.
- Keep this handy when you check-in as you will need to present your test results prior to boarding your flight to Grenada.

SGU ENROLLMENT LETTER

- SGU will email you this letter, which is addressed to the immigration authorities in Grenada and outlines your course of study. You will be required to present a physical copy of this letter to immigration upon your arrival in Grenada. If you do not receive this letter at least 7 days before your travel date, please contact us as noted below.

VISA UPON ARRIVAL LETTER

- SGU will email you a copy of the Visa Upon Arrival Letter. SGU students do not require a visa to enter Grenada. They will be issued a visa upon arrival. This letter states the policy in case you are asked about this as you travel to Grenada. If you do not receive this letter at least 7 days before your travel date, please reach out using the contact information below.

Travel guidelines are subject to change based on the Government of Grenada requirements so please check for updated requirements on Grenada's Ministry of Health website before traveling.
