(OPTIONAL) APPLY FOR ACCOMMODATIONS SERVICES

Students seeking accommodations for disabilities are required to contact Student Accessibility and Accommodation Services (SAAS) located in the Dean of Students Office (DOS). We highly recommend applying for accommodations as early as possible. Completing and submitting the form, along with the associated comprehensive documentation, at least one month before classes begin, will allow for a more efficient and timely consideration of your request. If we do not receive the required documentation in a timely fashion, an eligibility determination may not be made, and accommodations may not be granted before the commencement of classes and examinations. COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING APPLICATION *(NOT APPLICABLE FOR REMOTE LEARNERS)*

All incoming students must log into the [housing portal](#) and fill out a housing application whether they plan to live on-campus or off. Use the same credentials you use to access the SGU Portal and Student Self Service. Please note that all entering students are required to live on campus for their first two terms. You are eligible to seek off-campus housing if you bring children and/or pets or receive special permission through the Housing Office. If you intend to live off-campus, you must request the Housing Application on the portal and make sure you have obtained the necessary approval. Are you bringing a pet? AFTER DEPOSIT

SUBMIT YOUR FLIGHT DETAILS *(NOT APPLICABLE FOR REMOTE LEARNERS)*

We have created a secure form so you can update us on your travel plans back to campus.

When you have booked your flight to Grenada, visit the [**Flight Plan Back to Campus**](#) portal and log in with your SGU credentials to submit your flight details.

At the airport, you will be greeted by SGU ambassadors who will guide you through the testing, immigration and customs process as well as transportation to your quarantine location.

ELECTRONIC CUSTOMS FORM *(NOT APPLICABLE FOR REMOTE LEARNERS)*

St. George's University will pay the customs fees for electronic devices being brought to Grenada by students coming to Grenada for the first time. SGU will pay up to three electronic devices to include a computer/laptop, iPad/iPad mini, and a smartphone. Other types of devices (i.e., cameras) are not covered. Note that only one type of device per student, up to three devices, will be allowed.
