



## **CEPH is accepting third party comments for the re-accreditation of the MPH program at St. George's University**



The Master of Public Health (MPH) program at St. George's University is currently in its re-accreditation review cycle by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH). CEPH is an independent agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education to accredit schools and programs of public health within and outside the US. We will submit a final report on September 13th, 2022, and CEPH will conduct its site visit on October 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The MPH Program accreditation process is coordinated by the Chair of the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Dr. Christine Richards ([ricchr@sgu.edu](mailto:ricchr@sgu.edu)) and the Accreditation Coordinator, Dr. Tessa St. Cyr ([tstcyr@sgu.edu](mailto:tstcyr@sgu.edu)).

As part of its accreditation review and site visit, CEPH has a procedure for third-party comments that assures opportunity for students, alumni, faculty, the practice community, other stakeholders, and the general public, to provide written input into the deliberations of a site visit team. Third party comments provide the opportunity to submit feedback directly to CEPH on the school or program and its practices, procedures, and policies. Anyone who has relevant information may

submit a third-party comment, including individuals who are also participating in the site visit and self-study, if they want to provide additional comments.

As part of this process, we hereby notify our stakeholders and the general public that written third-party comments will be accepted by CEPH until September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
