

Grenada Pre-Travel Checklist

We can't wait to welcome you back to campus! But first, make sure you have everything on this mandatory checklist. When you have checked all boxes, you are ready to return!

TO DO BEFORE TRAVEL

- Get fully COVID-19 vaccinated
- Get a COVID-19 vaccine booster if eligible
- Confirm passport valid for six months from date of arrival
- Secure airline ticket
- Complete [SGU Flight Plan form](#)
- Complete SGU electronic customs form

GET FULLY COVID-19 VACCINATED

- The Government of Grenada has removed the State of Emergency. Both vaccinated and unvaccinated people can travel to Grenada by air or sea and will not be required to get tested on arrival.
- A negative antigen or PCR test and Travel Health Declaration Form is no longer required prior to or upon arrival.
- As part of our plan for a safe return to campus life, COVID-19 vaccinations will be required for all students, faculty, staff, administrators, vendors, and visitors on campus. All individuals who are eligible must also obtain a COVID-19 vaccine booster to their vaccination in order to gain access to our campus. [Review the student manual](#) for more detail.
- All students must be vaccinated in the country in which they are residing.
- Keep your COVID-19 vaccination card in a safe place. Take a photo with your phone as back-up.

CARRY ON DAY OF TRAVEL

- SGU Enrollment Letter or Student ID
- Visa Upon Arrival Letter
- Airline ticket
- Proof of vaccination card
- Passport valid for six months from date of arrival

VALID PASSPORT

- You will need a valid passport. Grenada requires passports to be valid for six months beyond the date of entry.

SGU FLIGHT PLAN FORM

- We have created a secure form so you can update us on your travel plans back to campus.
- When you have booked your flight to Grenada, visit the [Flight Plan Back to Campus portal](#) and log in with your SGU credentials to submit your flight details.

SGU ELECTRONIC CUSTOMS FORM

- If you are travelling to Grenada for the first time, SGU will cover the customs fees for up to three electronic devices that you register, for example, your cell phone, laptop and/or tablet.
- Bring a receipt for any additional devices if you have one. If you do not have a receipt, the custom fee will be calculated based on the estimated value of the device.

SGU ENROLLMENT LETTER OR STUDENT ID

- **Newly Accepted Students:** SGU will email you this letter, which is addressed to the immigration authorities in Grenada and outlines your course of study. You will be required to present a physical copy of this letter to immigration upon your arrival in Grenada. If you do not receive this letter at least 7 days before your travel date, please contact us as noted below.
- **Current Students:** You should travel with and present your SGU Student ID card.

VISA UPON ARRIVAL LETTER

- SGU will email you a copy of the Visa Upon Arrival Letter. SGU students do not require a visa to enter Grenada. They will be issued a visa upon arrival. This letter states the policy in case you are asked about this as you travel to Grenada. If you do not receive this letter at least 7 days before your travel date, please reach out using the contact information below.

UPON ARRIVAL IN GRENADA

- Airport Meet and Greet dates are listed on [the orientation site](#). An SGU ambassador will greet and direct you upon arrival. Once you have cleared Immigration and Customs, transportation to your dorm room on campus will be arranged and paid for by SGU.
- If you are residing off campus, you can use the [Grenada Airport Taxi Services](#), personal or other types of transportation. Please be prepared to cover the cost of transportation to your accommodation.
